Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) in schools and colleges in England

Dear Sir Liam,

Following my letter to you in September 2023 regarding Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC), we have been working closely with schools and colleges to support them to keep disruption to education at a minimum. Thanks to the hard work of school and college leaders, all schools and colleges with confirmed RAAC are providing full time face-to-face education for all pupils.

I am pleased to say we have concluded the Department for Education's RAAC identification programme. This means our questionnaire has now closed and any school or college that advised us they suspect they might have RAAC has had a survey to confirm if RAAC is present.

I am happy to inform you that today we have written to all schools and colleges confirming how they will be funded to remove RAAC permanently from their estate. Permanently removing RAAC may involve significant refurbishment of existing buildings or rebuilding. Schools and colleges will be funded either through grants or through the School Rebuilding Programme.
